2. Before they sinned, Adam and Eve were naked and not ashamed. What did they wear? Quote a relevant Bible passage in your answer.
3. Immediately after sinning, Adam and Eve realized that they were naked and felt ashamed, so they made garments for themselves out of fig leaves. What do these figs leaves symbolize?
4. What kind of clothing do we need in order to be clothed before God and not be ashamed?
5. Why God, being Omnipresent, after Adam's sin goes to look for him and asks: '*Adam, where are you*'?
6. Following Adam's sin, Satan hoped that humanity's fate would mirror his own. However, he was unaware of one of God's attributes that grants us salvation. What is this attribute?
7. Even the serpent, an animal, was rebuked by God. What was this rebuke?
8. In your own words, explain God's judgement on Satan in Genesis 3:15.
9. What were the consequences for women because of the sin?
10. Name one consequence of man's sin for him and one for the Earth.
