- 5- King Nebuchadnezzar had a dream, but he could not remember it. How did the king try to find out about the dream? How did God use Daniel to tell the king about the dream? (Daniel 2:1~28)
- 6- In your own words, retell the story of Nebuchadnezzar's dream (Daniel 2:29~35).
- 7- In your own words, explain Daniel's interpretation of the dream (Daniel 2:36~49).
- 8- Satan has always wanted to establish a world kingdom on Earth. What was his first attempt? Cite the relevant Bible passages.
- 9- Why will God allow Satan to establish a global kingdom during the Tribulation?
- 10- What became Daniel's concern after he interpreted Nebuchadnezzar's dream?
