3- Is the word 'stone' used in the Bible to refer to man? Explain your answer and quote some relevant passages.

4- In the passage quoted in Question 1 above, who is the stone that Jesus refers to? Quote passages from the New Testament to support your answer.

5- Justify the statement using the passage Galatians 2:7–9: Peter did not lead the Church in Rome.

6- Who was known as the 'Apostle to the Gentiles'? Quote a passage to justify your answer.

7- Jesus said to Peter, '*I will give you the keys to the Kingdom of Heaven.*' Explain in your own words what this means. Support your answer with biblical references.

8- At the beginning of his ministry, Jesus offered the kingdom to Israel, and the Jews could have accepted. On what day would he have been crowned if the Jews had accepted Jesus as King? Quote the biblical passage.

9- Explain Jesus's response to the Pharisees: '*If they keep silent, the stones will cry out.*'
